

Cheri Ann Gallagher Background

Cheri Ann Gallagher was the daughter of Mamie Douglas, one of the first women to become a bishop and Pastor in the Church of God in Christ Christian denomination. Cheri was one of the third oldest of eight children. She was baptized in the Holy Spirit at the tender age of 4 years old. She began preaching at 13 years old. Cheri was a very creative and passionate person. She was a poet, a singer-songwriter, an artist, and an inventor. She sang, wrote songs and traveled extensively over the United States as a singer, prophet and evangelist in her early twenties.

She founded a talent scout business in her hometown of Saint Louis and was also hired to write as a songwriter for various recording artists. She turned down contracts with both Motown and Monument Records, in order to better pursue her passion for ministry. Later she went on to create two highly successful Gospel radio shows: Freedom Cross and Gospel Kaleidoscope.

Gospel Kaleidoscope, her most successful show, was a syndicated gospel radio program that ran for over 15 years from the late 1980's to the early 2000's. It started as a half hour program and eventually grew to become an hour long broadcast on KATZ, KIRL, KSTL, WESL, and WGNU.

Gospel Kaleidoscope changed the patterns of gospel promotion and production through conversational, inspirational, informational, and motivational interviews which showcased well known and up-and-coming recording artists in their talent showcase segment. Gospel Kaleidoscope also hosted 12 other gospel related segments (13 in total) from commercial free Gospel Jam Sessions, a Health and Wealth Segment and several discussion round tables from Youthview Point to both a Men and a Women's Forum. Each segment had its own focus and flavor that Cheri hoped would give the listening audience a wealth of information, encouragement and entertainment.

Cheri Gallagher went on to found the not-for-profit community fundraising organization "Keep Reaching Foundation", which organized support from the local churches and other community leaders to raise funds for organizations and outreaches doing good work in the Saint Louis area. One of her best known works was creating a partnership between Keep Reaching Foundation and the Lou Brock Scholarship Fund to help educate at-risk youth.

Cheri had a number of highly respected co-hosts and producers working with her to bring her vision to life over the years, such as the award winning radio talk show personality Columbus Gregory, Chuck Spearman, and Ben Fleming. Cheri Gallagher was well known and loved within the radio announcer and talk show hosts community.

In her later years, Cheri invented and created several unique products, which are patent pending. Her most notable is the whole body tonic "Aloe Vera Health Plus" which was a healing

recipe she received directly from God and which her and her husband testified kept them free from all colds for over 10 years.

Last but not least, twelve months before her passing, during the covid scare, Cheri rose to the challenge of meeting people's ministry needs outside the church walls. With a mission from God she began what is now IGBN, the Internet Gospel Broadcasting Network. IGBN is dedicated to providing churches, Christian ministers and performers no-cost avenues of spreading the Gospel around the world. Cheri's vision and passion has carried her dream forward even after her home-going. IGBN has expanded to new offices and we have our official launch on July 17, 2021 with a fundraising telethon and prayer hotline from noon to midnight. This is the beginning of great things and we believe Cheri is watching from heaven and cheering us on.

Salvation

The Gospel Presentation:

1. **The First Man (Adam) was born spiritually alive**, but through sin he not only died spiritually but he transferred an inherited terminal condition called “spiritual death” to all of his descendants.

“And the LORD God formed man [of] the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.” - Gen 2:7 (KJV)

“For since by a man came death...” 1 Corinthians 15:21a (NASB)

“Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: ... Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come.”
Rom 5:12, 14 (KJV)

2. **We are all born Spiritually Dead through the sin of Adam and Eve.** This is the inherited death that comes by original sin. However, because we are born spiritually dead, our souls poisoned/corrupted by this death leads us to increase death's grip on us by our own personal sins (trespasses)

“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” Romans 3:23 (NKJV)

And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest. (NASB)
Ephesians 2:1-3

“Consequently, just as one trespass resulted in condemnation for all people...”
Rom 5:18a (NIV)

3. **Sin separates us from the presence and life of God**

“But your iniquities have separated between you and your God” Isa 59:2a (KJV)

“That at that time ye were without Christ..having no hope, and without God in the world” Eph 2:12 (KJV)

“Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart” Eph 4:18 (KJV)

4. The penalty (or result) of sin is death

“The soul that sinneth, it shall die.” Ezek 18:20a

“Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.” Ezek 18:4

“For the wages of sin is death” Rom 6:23a

5. God isn't mad at you. He doesn't want you to die

“But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.” Ezek 18: 21 (KJV)

“Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith the Lord God: and not that he should return from his ways, and live?” Ezek 18:22 (KJV)

6. God loves you and wants you to live!

“But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places, in Christ Jesus” Ephesians 2:4-6 (NASB)

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” Jhn 3:16 (KJV)

7. Jesus paid the price for our sin

“You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” Rom 5:6-8 (NIV)

8. Through Jesus we can be made spiritually alive again!

And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam [was made] a quickening spirit. - 1Co 15:45 KJV

(Jesus Speaking) “The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly.” Jhn 10:10 (KJV)

For since by a man came death, by a man also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all shall be made alive. (NASB) 1 Corinthians 15:21-22

9. But to be made spiritually alive we have to be born again of the Spirit.

Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again." - Jhn 3:3 NIV

Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. - Jhn 3:3, 5-6 NIV

10. How can we receive salvation and be born again?

He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved--you and your household." - Act 16:30-31 NIV

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. - Rom 10:13 KJV

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. - Rom 10:9-10 KJV

Now is the Day of Salvation

1. Jesus has issued you a personal invitation

Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. - Rev 3:20 KJV

And again Jesus spoke to them in parables, saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son, and sent his servants to call those who were invited to the wedding feast, but they would not come. Again he sent other servants, saying, 'Tell those who are invited, "See, I have prepared my dinner, my oxen and my fat calves have been slaughtered, and everything is ready. Come to the wedding feast.'" But they paid no attention and went off, one to his farm, another to his business, ... The king was angry, and he sent his troops and destroyed those murderers and burned their city. Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding feast is ready, but those invited were not worthy. Go therefore to the main roads and invite to the wedding feast as many as you find.' - Mat 22:1-5, 7-9 ESV

2. You've heard the Gospel. Now it's time to decide.

Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. - Isa 55:6-7 KJV

3. Don't wait to get saved

How do you know what your life will be like tomorrow? Your life is like the morning fog--it's here a little while, then it's gone. - Jas 4:14 NLT

And that, knowing the time, that now [it is] high time to awake out of sleep: for now [is] our salvation nearer than when we believed. - Rom 13:11 KJV

(For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now [is] the accepted time; behold, now [is] the day of salvation.) - 2Co 6:2 KJV

4. Act NOW!

Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. - Mar 16:16 ESV

STEPS TO SALVATION

The prayer of salvation is just a vehicle through which you activate your faith in Christ. Praying this prayer won't save you. It is Jesus who saves and it is Faith in Jesus that allows you to receive that salvation. However, confession is also a part of the salvation process. Read the following steps and then IN FAITH pray the prayer, believing you receive when you pray and you SHALL BE SAVED!

1. **YOU ARE A SINNER!**

Believe in and confess your NEED for Salvation (Rom 3:23; Rom 5:12, 14)

2. **JESUS IS YOUR SALVATION!**

Believe and confess that Jesus is the Solution you your NEED. Believing Jesus is your salvation and the solution to your sin requires knowing of him and his life. It means accepting the dual nature of his existence as both fully God and fully man. Believing the virgin birth, his death at the cross for your sin, his burial, his resurrection, his appearances afterward, his ascension and his coming return. (Rom 10:9-10; Jhn 14:6)

3. **RECEIVE SALVATION!**

Ask in Faith for Jesus' help. You cannot save yourself. (Rom 10:13; Matt 7:7; Jhn 6:37)

4. **YOU ARE SAVED!**

Believe and Confess you have received. You are a new creation. (Mk 11:22, 24; Rom 8:1, 15-17; 2 Cor 5:17)

5. **LIVE SAVED!**

Having been crucified in Christ, allow Christ to live through you. (Gal 2:20; Rom 12:1-2)

6. **LIVE FREE!** *You have been set free. (Jhn 8:36; Jhn 8:32; 2 Cor 3:16-18)*

7. **YOU ARE A SAINT!** *Do not call yourself a sinner any more. You may miss the mark from time to time but your sin nature has died. You are a blood-bought, blood washed saint of God. You have been separated and set apart for God. Act like it! (Rom 1:7; Rom 6:5-7; 1 Cor 1:2, 6:20, 14:33; 2 Cor 6:17; Tit 2:11-14; 1 Pet 2:9; Eph 2:19)*

Prayer of Salvation

Heavenly Father,

STEP ONE

I am a sinner! I was born in sin and I have sinned! I need your salvation! I need you to free me from my bondage to sin and deliver me from the power of the enemy. Bring me out of darkness into the Kingdom of Light. Restore to me your life and all that was lost by man in the Garden of Eden. Restore to me my dominion and self-control. I want to enjoy life in you!

STEP TWO PART A

Jesus, I believe and acknowledge that you are the truth, the way and the life! You are the only way to the Father, and to try to come any other way would make me a thief and a robber.

STEP TWO PART B

Note: If you have not read any of the gospels you may not be able to see the rest of step two in faith. If that is the case, skip it (except the portion about his death, burial and resurrection... that is the minimum of what you must believe to receive salvation). Go directly to step three for now. However, after praying this prayer it's important to read through at least one of the gospels. When you are done please come back to confess part 2.

Jesus, I believe that you are the pre-incarnate Word of God that existed with God before the creation of the world, and that you are God. You were not created. You have no beginning and no end. I believe that by the power of the Holy Spirit, you (the Word of God) entered a virgin and became flesh, fulfilling the prophecy you gave that the Messiah of the Hebrews would be called Emmanuel, God With Us.

Jesus, I believe that as the Word That Became Flesh you forever took on the dual nature of Fully God and Fully Man. While on earth Jesus you lived as a man, refusing to use your divine powers, so that you could be our example. As a full man you lived a sinless life with the same resources available to me, faith in God and the help of the Holy Spirit. Though you did not sin and the Jews had no reason to arrest you, you were taken up in chains, lied against, interrogated by the Jewish leaders and eventually given over to Pontius Pilate for judgement.

Pontius Pilate found no fault in you Jesus, yet the people still cried out for Barabas to be released and for you to be crucified. I believe Jesus all these things had to happen to fulfill the prophecies spoken of concerning the Messiah, the awaited Anointed One of the Jews, through whom God promised to reveal his salvation to the Jew first and then the Greeks. I believe Jesus that you were beaten, scourged, crowned with a crown of thorns, robbed and mocked as the King of the Jews. Yet you remained silent and did not call your legion of angels to remove you from the cross. Jesus, I believe you had to die such a horrible death because of the utter depravity of man's corrupted and sinful nature.

You became a curse for my sake Jesus, for cursed is everyone who dies upon a tree, that I might be freed from the curse of the law, which is sin, sickness and death. I believe that you died, willingly giving your life (no one could take your life from you). You went to hell and were raised from the dead after three days, bringing with you gifts for men. You showed yourself alive to the disciples and hundreds of people before ascending to heaven to sit at the right hand of the Father. Jesus as the perfect spotless lamb that was slain, you are able to wash me of the deepest stains of all my sins. Nothing is impossible for you! Through your finished work of the cross, you broke the power of death. I do not have to die, and if I die in the body yet I will live in the spirit until you return to resurrect my body and set up your Kingdom on earth.

Jesus, I believe that you will return. And when you do return you will do so this time as the conquering lion instead of the lamb. I believe you alone are worthy and have been given the authority to bring about the end of the world and the Judgement. Yet you did not come to condemn the world but to save those like me you are willing to believe in you. You came to give me your abundant life.

STEP THREE

Help me Jesus! I admit I cannot help or save myself. I can not even come to you unless you draw me. You have drawn me therefore I trust you want me to be saved. As a sinner I absolutely deserve to die the death you died. But you are a holy sinless man and my God took my place. I believe you endured the pain and the shame of the cross Jesus, for me! My salvation and restoration to relationship with the Father and you, was the joy that motivated you to complete the work set for you by the Father, to destroy the works of the devil.

Forgive me Jesus for the sin nature I inherited through Adam, my past unbelief and my own personal sins. If there is any confusion, doubt or remaining unbelief, Jesus, reveal it to me and help me to nail it to the cross! I believe, God! Help my unbelief. Jesus, you said that everyone who asks receives. Save me Jesus and wash me white as snow! Justify and sanctify me that I might be able to walk in the fullness of this new nature and new life. Help me Holy Spirit to live for Jesus as you show me how.

Holy Spirit, remove my spiritual blindness and deafness. Give me eyes to hear and ears to hear that I might be moved and changed by the Word of God. Bring the Word of God to life for me. Reveal the mystery of the Kingdom of God and of Christ to me. Father God, grant me the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Christ Jesus, enlighten the eyes of my understanding that I may know what is the hope of his calling and his inheritance in the saints. Teach me the Word of God Holy Spirit! Let it cleanse me of every unrighteous way and empower me to obtain spiritual victory in every situation. For your mercy, your grace and your love I thank you. I receive now by faith all that I have prayed for. I receive the fullness of the salvation you paid for me Jesus, the rescue from sin, the spiritual and physical deliverance and healing from anything and everything that would hinder my fulfilling your call for me.

STEP FOUR

I have the joy of salvation! Thank you God, I am saved, and born again! I am a new creation, the old things have passed away and all things are become new.

STEP FIVE

I am saved and I will act like it. I will confess you before men and be your witness in the earth. Let all the signs of the believer follow me God. I will cast out demons in your name, I will receive the Baptism in your Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in new tongues, I will take up serpents (exercise my authority over demonic spirits, principalities, powers and wickedness in high places). If I drink any deadly thing it will not harm me. I will lay hands on the sick and they will recover. I have received the full measure of faith, all the faith I need to move every mountain in my life. I have received the same faith as the apostles - the faith of Jesus (who is God). I will stand by faith, walk by faith and live by faith.

STEP SIX

I will guard my heart for out of it flows the issues of life. Cleanse my mouth, Lord, and put a guard at my lips so that I will not offend you or speak death into my new life.

STEP SEVEN

I am no longer a sinner but a saint. I am not my own. I have been bought with a price. I no longer live my life for myself or according to my own agenda for the fulfillment of my selfish desires! I am yours God to do with what you like. Lead me and guide me according to your truth, through your Word and by your Spirit. I am not ashamed of your gospel or my change in status.

Jesus I believe you have given me authority over the powers of the enemy. I believe that the same works you did I will do and greater. I believe it because your word is true. Help me to order my life according to your truth. Help me to find a christian community of believers that are established in the full Gospel, your incorruptible Word. Divinely connect me with those people who can help root me in your love, your word and the faith. In Jesus name I pray and receive. Those who trust in you God will not be disappointed or put to shame!

Now That You Are Saved What Should You Do?

1. Water Baptism is an outward acknowledgement of an inward work God has done in us by faith. It also prepares the believer for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

“Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost” Mat 28:19 (KJV)

“And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord.” Act 10:48a (KJV)

And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord. - Act 22:16 KJV

The like figure whereunto [even] baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ: - 1Pe 3:21 KJV

Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead. And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; - Col 2:12-13 KJV

For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. - Gal 3:27 KJV

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. - Act 2:38 KJV

2. The Baptism of the Holy Spirit is a secondary experience than the work of the Holy Spirit in Salvation which seals us until the day of Jesus' return. The Baptism of the Holy Spirit empowers us to be witnesses and to do the work of the ministry. The Holy Spirit is received by faith and confession just like salvation.

THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN SALVATION

That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows where it wishes, and

you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit." - Jhn 3:6-8 ESV

"In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory." Eph 1:13-14 (ESV)

Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, 'Give me a drink,' you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water." ... Jesus said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." - Jhn 4:10, 13-14 ESV

But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth." - Jhn 4:10, 13-14, 21-24 ESV

THE BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

[Paul] asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" They answered, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." So Paul asked, "Then what baptism did you receive?" "John's baptism," they replied. Paul said, "John's baptism was a baptism of repentance. He told the people to believe in the one coming after him, that is, in Jesus." On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied. - Act 19:2-6 NIV

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." - Act 1:8 NIV

When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. ... And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. - Act 2:1, 4 ESV

HOW TO RECEIVE THE BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if [he ask] a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall [your] heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him? - Luk 11:9-13 KJV

3. Read and obey the Word of God

“Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed [thereto] according to thy word.” Psa 119:9 “KJV”

Thy word [is] a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path. - Psa 119:105 KJV

“All scripture [is] given by inspiration of God, and [is] profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.” 2Ti 3:16-17 (KJV)

“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, [which is] your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.” Rom 12:1-2 (KJV)

“...be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. - Jas 1:22 KJV

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.” 2Ti 2:15 (KJV)

“Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, [then] are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.” Jhn 8:31-32 (KJV)

Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places]. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith,

wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; - Eph 6:11-18 KJV

4. Assemble with other Christians (both in the local church services and outside of it)

And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some [is]; but exhorting [one another]: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. - Heb 10:24-25 KJV

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. - Col 3:16 KJV

I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD. - Psa 122:1 KJV

5. Pray with understanding (human language)

And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. Give us day by day our daily bread. And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. - Luk 11:2-4 KJV

Pray without ceasing. - 1Th 5:17 KJV

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. - Phl 4:6-7 KJV

6. Pray in tongues

And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. - Act 2:4 KJV

And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; - Mar 16:17 KJV

For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter, - Act 10:46 KJV

For he that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth [him]; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries. ... I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all: - 1Co 14:2, 18 KJV

For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. - 1Co 2:11 KJV

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what [is] the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to [the will of] God. - Rom 8:26-27 KJV

7. Share Christ and the gospel of the Kingdom of God

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. - Rom 1:16 KJV

Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; - 2Ti 1:8 KJV

Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. - Mat 10:32 KJV
